



Recycled fiber content in Roseburg UltraBlend, SkyBlend, and Duramine composite panel

This letter addresses questions related to the recycled fiber content in particleboard products produced by Roseburg. Some of today's green building specifications give different levels of credit for the use of recycled content in project building materials and furnishings. **Roseburg particleboard is 3rd party certified to contain 100% recycled and/or recovered fiber** in accordance with the Eco-Certified Composite standard CPA 4-11 fiber classifications (ECC certificate available by mill location at www.Roseburg.com). We recommend that project managers taking a recycled content credit consider our particleboard product for the **pre-consumer content** portion of this credit only (100% pre-consumer and 0% post consumer).

Following are recommended values to use for basis weight calculations to account for the resin, wax, and other additives that remain in solid form in the panel and to account for the weight of the paper/resin laminate in our Duramine panels:

<u>UltraBlend and SkyBlend Particleboard:</u>	<u>90%</u> basis weight pre-consumer recycled content
<u>Duramine (Decorative Melamine):</u>	<u>86%</u> basis weight pre-consumer recycled content
