## California Proposition 65 Statement of Compliance

Dear Valued Customer,

Proposition 65, officially known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, was enacted as a ballot initiative in November 1986 in California. The proposition protects the state's drinking water sources from contamination by chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm, and requires businesses to inform Californians about exposure to such chemicals. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or encountered after release into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Roseburg is firmly committed to complying with Proposition 65 and ensuring that our California business partners and consumers are properly notified of any harmful chemicals present in our products or in the products that are further manufactured from Roseburg materials. Roseburg partners with the Western Wood Products Association (WWPA) to assist with its annual Prop 65 notification campaign to all active customers and provides appropriate warning labels on its products, in compliance with California's Prop 65.
